**The Traffic and Road Safety (Appeal) (Amendment) Regulations,
2023.**

*(Under section 178 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998,
Cap. 361)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by section 178 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act 1998, these Regulations are made this 14th day of March, 2023.

1. Title

These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Appeal) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

2. Amendment of S.I. 361-66

The Traffic and Road Safety (Appeal) Regulations, herein after referred to as principal Regulations, are amended in regulation 2—

- (a) by repealing the definitions of “board” and “secretary” .; and
- (b) by inserting the following definitions in their alphabetic order—

““chief licensing officer” means the chief licensing officer of motor vehicles designated under section 3 of the Act and includes a deputy chief licensing officer;”

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner responsible for Transport Regulation and Safety;

“Competent Authority” means the department of transport regulation and safety in the Ministry responsible for transport;”.

3. Amendment of principal Regulations

The principal Regulations are amended by substituting for the word “Board” wherever it appears, the words “Competent Authority”

4. Amendment of principal Regulations

Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (3), by substituting for the word “secretary” wherever it appears the words “chief licensing officer or Commissioner”;
