The Traffic and Road Safety (Driving Schools and Driving Instructors) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

(Under sections 37 and 59 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by sections 37 and 59 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act 1998, these Regulations are made this 14th, day of March, 2023.

1. Title

These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Driving Schools and Driving Instructors) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

2. Amendment of S.I. No. 29 of 2010

The Traffic and Road Safety (Driving Schools and Driving Instructors) Regulations, 2010 herein after referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended by substituting for the title “Director of Transport” wherever it appears, the title “chief licensing officer”.

3. Amendment of regulation 3 of principal Regulations

Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (2) the following—

“(2) A person who operates a driving school without a valid licence issued under the Act and these Regulations, commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding thirty currency points or imprisonment not exceeding one year, or both.”

4. Amendment of regulation 4 of principal Regulations

Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (2) (d) the following—

“(d) has up-to-date copies of learner drivers training materials, including training curriculum and manuals issued by the Ministry responsible for transport;”.

5. Amendment of regulation 11 of principal Regulations

Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (2)—

- (a) by substituting for paragraph (b) the following—
 - “(b) in case of a group B motor vehicles, is fitted with dual brakes and dual clutches, where the motor vehicle is a manual transmission vehicle and with dual brakes, where the motor vehicle is an automatic transmission vehicle in addition to double peddles;”
- (b) in paragraph (c), by substituting for the words “groups A, F, H and I” the words “groups A, BI, N and G”

6. Amendment of regulation 13 of principal Regulations

Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting subregulation (1) the following—

“(1) The training course for learner drivers shall be conducted by a licensed instructor using learner driver training materials, including training curriculum and manuals issued by the Ministry responsible for transport.”

7. Amendment of regulation 19 of principal Regulations

Regulation 19 of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in subregulation (1), by inserting immediately after paragraph (g) the following—
 - “(h) submit proof that he or she is certified or accredited as a motor vehicle instructor by the Directorate of Industrial Training or other assessment body authorised by law.”;

(b) by substituting for subregulation (2) the following—

“(2) A person shall not be issued with a driving instructor’s licence, unless he or she has paid the fee for the category of licence prescribed in Schedule 2 to these Regulations.”

8. Amendment of regulation 25 of principal Regulations

Regulation 25 of the principal Regulations is amended, by substituting for subregulation (1) the following—

“(1) A driving instructor shall, while instructing, teaching or supervising a learner, be in possession of a copy of his or her driving instructor’s licence and, upon request by a police officer or the chief licensing officer, within forty eight hours, produce the original copy of his or her driving instructor’s licence”.

9. Amendment of Schedule 2 of principal Regulations

Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in item 3 relating to regulation 15, by inserting immediately after the words “driving instructors” in paragraph (1) and (2) the words “or drivers”;
- (b) in item 4 relating to regulation 18 and 19, by inserting immediately after the words “driving instructors” the words “or drivers”;
